3. What will we do?

6:00 pm- Show up at Round Lake Retreat Center (see directions below) and enjoy a pizza dinner with us. Take time to eat, unpack your things in one of the assigned lodging areas, and hang out with the rest of us fun women!

7:30 pm- Our first main session time will begin in the conference room. We'll play some games and learn some cool stuff together.

8:30 pm- We'll break for some time extra time to settle in or hang out with some friends.

9:00 pm- We'll meet for another main session in the conference room to continue to learn and grow together.

10:30 pm- This will be your free time. Go to your lodging area to sleep or, hang out in one of the many common areas to spend time with friends. Hey- this is time for you!

Saturday May 14th:

8:00 am- Breakfast will be served in the Round Lake Cafeteria (a very short walking distance from the Retreat Center). You can wake up early or sleep in a little. There are plenty of wonderful, clean bathrooms with showers in the Retreat Center.

9:00 am- Another main session will once again be in the conference room.

10:30 am- This will be free time for you to enjoy the amenities at Round Lake, take a walk, pray with someone, or spend some time alone or with friends.

4. What should I bring?

- Rooms are dormitory style with twin bunk beds. You'll need to bring your own bedding and pillows.

5. Where will we be?

- We will be at Round Lake Christian Camp located at 114 St. Rt. 3 Lakeville, Ohio 44638.
- Directions from New Hope Westwood Campus: Head up to Rt. 3 (stop light by the Bell Store Gas Station). Turn left onto Rt. 3. Continuing following Rt. 3 (South) for about 15 minutes. You will see Round Lake Christian Camp on your right. Turn right into the drive and continue to follow the main drive into the camp. Once you have passed the small playground area, turn right and go up the hill to park in front of the Retreat Center.
